

INFANTS (UP TO YEAR 2)

We suggest parents go through the material as listed below with the children. Or, children can watch the video during the sermon then do the other activities with parents' help afterwards.

Mark 9v1-8. Big idea: See Jesus' amazing glory – he's so important, we should listen to him.

1. Play a short game of 'Jesus Says' (like Simon Says).

An adult gives commands for the children to follow – 'sit down, stand up, pat your head' etc. However, the children should only follow the command when it begins with 'Jesus says...'. The children will have to listen carefully. Tell the children that in today's true story from the Bible we're going to see Jesus is so important that we should listen to him.

This includes a song to sing at the end, with actions: 'I'm following the King'.

3. Craft.

Print and assemble the Infants craft found in the Google Drive to reinforce the teaching point and apply.

Mark 9v1-13. Big idea: Amazing glory will come after Jesus dies.
