

INFANTS (UP TO YEAR 2)

We suggest parents go through the material as listed below with the children. Or, children can watch the video during the sermon then do the other activities with parents' help afterwards.

Mark 11v1-11. Big idea: Jesus is God's promised king coming to save.

1. Activity – drama

In the Google Drive is a short script and directions for a drama you could do as a family to act out the passage.

2. Watch the 24 May Infants teaching video: go to YouTube.com and search for 'Matthias Youth' channel

At the start of the video is a song to sing, with actions: 'I'm following the King'.

At the end of the video is another song with actions: 'Super Saviour'

3. Craft

Print and assemble the Infants craft found in the Google Drive to reinforce the teaching point and apply.

Pray with the children about what they've learnt.
